1. Introductions, Land Acknowledgement, and Acceptance of Minutes, led by Joanne Huber

2. Admin Report, presented by Vice -Principal Lillian Papel

 - Subway Lunch School Cash Online It was confusing as the lunch appeared as a banner ad so, people could not order but are not hearing from a lot of people that it is not an issue. Overall there aren't that many families who have opted in.
 - High Park Open House November 29, 2023 Gives families an opportunity to visit HPAS and find out about our programs and can apply in January
 - Winter Concert December 13th Helena and Betty are leads for the concert.

- *EQAO Results* Lillian walked through the EQAO results If you want to see more information go to the EQAO website. Information is used by staff and school improvement teams to see where students could use help.
 - Grade 3 Results 12 students wrote the test % of students achieving at provincial standards- 75% Math, 100% Reading, 83% Writing

3. Teacher Report, presented by Eva and Daniel

- Wish List Staff have been reminded to purchase items and submit receipts to HPAS Council
- Jacob Rodenburg Coming in to do Professional Development with teachers.
 His expertise is outdoor education, and he will be suggesting classroom
 activities for different age groups.
- Winter Concert -
 - Changes to how implemented Use classrooms as Green Room so we will need parent volunteers (from 6:10) as runners.
 - Need help with formatting programs, runners to let us know when to bring students to the stage.
 - Also need parents to help with decorations, clean up.
 - Helena needs help/clarification with the sound board and help convert Youtube music to an MP3.
 - Joanne to send out a call for parents to bring baked goods for the Winter concert.
 - Lillian to reach out to Helena and Betty to confirm classes cannot be collapsed.
 - Parent Council members expressed sadness and concern at the change from having all students in the gym during the concert, on the basis of siblings being able to see one another's performances, feelings of community created by all being together and concern that the grown-ups who volunteer for this kind of thing are also the ones most likely to want to see the entire concert.

4. HPAS Council Report, presented by Joanne Huber

- Signatories have not been changed over yet but will be done by end of this month. Bank Account currently has \$13,241 in account.
 - Will wait until Movie Night is over to make up deposit.
- Envelope Fundraiser -
 - \sim \$7,000 (has far exceeded our expectations). So uniforms, technology can all be done.
- Climate Action Grant -

- We did not receive this Grant (meant for Bike Rally).
- (PRO Grant) School Council Innovation Grant Roberta -
 - Still waiting to hear about the Grant. Roberta connected with Jump Mathematics (they will come make a Math Friendly home)- Session will include book (Myth of Ability) and session. Idea is to also tie in with a Math Olympics with the children. Cost of the session is only \$300.
- HPAS Reads -
 - Deadline extended by one week and not a lot of children from older grades submitting. Draws for Readers who submitted Bingo Cards -
 - Bingo Card Winners Emergent (Aurelia), Early(Dylan) and Transitional (Petro), Fluent Readers (not awarded), There is still a \$75
 Type Books gift card that has gone unaccounted for could divide between 3 older teachers, donate to library? Maybe tie it to the author visit.
 - Next year we may consider doing a digital card or app that could be used
 - Could students create something to motivate them to read. (Anastasia, Eva and Danielle to lead). Daniel and Eva will take this back to the staff to discuss what the students can do.
 - A suggestion was made to move the event to February/March.
- Author Visits Grades 5/6 and 7/8 will have an author visit later in the year.
